PRESS RELEASE

The 39th Victory Day of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has been observed here in Abu Dhabi in a befitting manner. H.E. Mr. Md. Nazmul Quanine, Ambassador of Bangladesh to the U.A.E. hoisted the National Flag at the Chancery premises in presence of all the officers/officials of the Embassy, students and teachers from Shaikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Bangladesh Islamia School and a cross section of the Bangladesh community members. On this day in 1971, Bangladesh emerged as an independent country after nine months of bloody war.

The day's programme was started with the recitation from the Holy Quran followed by a discussion meeting held at the Chancery, where H.E. the Ambassador and representatives from different professional groups of Bangladesh community spoke on the significance of the day and the historic role of father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. They highlighted the sacrifice made by the martyrs of the War of Liberation for the independence of Bangladesh. Students from Sheikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Bangladesh Islamia School, Abu Dhabi, took part in recitation of poems and patriotic songs.

Photographers from local newspapers like the Khaleej Times and the Gulf News and representatives of Bangladeshi private TV channels were also present to cover the programme.

The programme was concluded with special prayers for the salvation of the souls of martyrs of the War of Liberation and peace and prosperity of the country.
